





- Unfold the liner, and lay it flat on an even, level surface.
 Ensure no sharp stones or other debris are under the liner.
- 2. Insert the legs into the vertical pockets on the outside of the tank. Make sure the circular cut outs are at the top.
- 3. Assemble the top ring by connecting the curves poles together end-to-end.
- 4. Push the top ring into the circular cut outs on the legs. This will require a slight amount of force. Be careful of sharp edges.
- 5. Wrap the flaps around the top ring to secure the liner. Space them out as evenly as possible.
- 6. The plastic ball valve can be installed at any time, we recommend wrapping PTFE tape (included) around the male threads, this ensures a tight seal and no leaks.
- Ensure no sharp objects are used or located around the tank. Keep children away to prevent the risk of injury or drowning.
